MEMORANDUM ON COOPERATION IN THE FUNCTIONING OF THE REGIONAL CENTRE FOR JUDICIAL TRAINING ON CYBERCRIME

Article 1

The Signatories to this Memorandum on Cooperation (hereinafter the "Memorandum") shall be as follows: Albanian School of Magistrates, Bosnia and Herzegovina Public Institution Centre for Judicial and Prosecutorial Training of the FBiH, Public Institution Center for Judicial and Prosecutorial Training of the Republika Srpska (Bosnia and Herzegovina), Judicial Academy (Croatia), Kosovo Judicial Institute, Academy for Judges and Prosecutors of the Republic of Macedonia, Judicial Training Centre of Montenegro, Judicial Academy of Republic of Serbia, Justice Academy of Turkey.

These institutions are hereby establishing cooperation with the aim of enabling the functioning of the Regional Centre for Judicial Training on Cybercrime at the Judicial Academy of Croatia (hereinafter the "Regional Centre").

The cooperation shall be particularly focused on providing support in developing and delivering the trainings on electronic evidence and on the prevention and suppression of cybercrime for judges and prosecutors of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo¹, Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia and Turkey, i.e. the countries/areas that have participated in the European Union/Council of Europe Joint Project Cybercrime@IPA (Regional Cooperation in Criminal Justice: Strengthening capacities in the fight against cybercrime).

Article 2

The scope of cooperation shall include the following:

- Drafting the annual work programme of the Regional Centre;
- The organisation of regional training activities on cybercrime and electronic evidence as set in the annual work programme;
- The establishment and update of the pool of trainers from among relevant experts;
- Dissemination of the training materials to national judges and prosecutors;
- Support in the training needs analyses and the evaluation of trainings;
- Support in the preparation of project proposals to be funded from the EU and other sources.

Article 3

The Regional Centre shall be managed by a board consisting of the heads of the judicial training institutions as listed in Article 1 above or their nominated deputies.

The day-to-day administration of the Regional Centre shall be conducted by the Judicial Academy of Croatia.

The activities shall take place in all the countries/areas as specified in Article 1 above.

Article 4

The activities of the Regional Centre shall be financed on project basis from national and international sources. All the Signatories shall seek to find the funds for the activities of the Regional Centre.

Article 5

If any of the Signatories proposes a modification to this Memorandum, this shall be done in writing and agreed by all the other Signatories.

¹ This designation is without prejudice to positions on status, and is in line with UNSC 1244 and the ICJ Opinion on the Kosovo Declaration of Independence.

Article 6

This Memorandum shall enter into force on the date of its signing by the representatives of all the Signatories.


It shall remain in force for three years and it shall be renewed automatically upon its expiry unless any of the Signatories objects thereto.






